

PRESIDENT MESSAGE:



After a 10 minute break we resumed with **committee reports**.


- ❖ **Membership**-38 present and several guests

- ❖ **Chicken Quilt Show**- Judy and Joan passed out a fat quarter and rules for a new chicken challenge to be done by the November meeting.
- ❖ **Winter Retreat**- Ginny Hendrix is working on a retreat for us at camp Will-A-Way. The money would need to be in December 1, 2011 and room for 25 people, meals included. More details in coming newsletter.
- ❖ **Sunshine**- Eliza told us that Jean Swinwood and her husband are having a rough time of it. Send a card if you can.
- ❖ **Eagle Ranch**- Betty read some thank-you notes from some girls at Eagle Ranch that got quilts. Twenty-three people brought back the 9 patch blocks they made for our Eagle Ranch effort. The winner of 12 blocks was Diana Carrillo. The next block will be a pin wheel and the directions will be in the newsletter. Project Day will be next Monday, July 18, 2011. We were urged to sign up and bring a salad. We also received 10 quilts from Cathy Ethridge. Lydia invited us to project day in September which we will be having a Jelly Roll Race. In order to participate in this race you will need to purchase a Jelly roll or have 40 strips of 2 1/2 inch fabric.

We presented Fay with a quilt that the board had made for her. She was a co-president last year. **Terry Powers** thanked those who brought refreshments and called out those who will do it next month. After Show and Tell and drawing the meeting was closed.




MEMBERSHIP




Make 4 half square triangle units.
Each unit should measure $6\frac{1}{2}$ inches.



Arrange Units As
Shown Above
and Sew Into Two
Rows

Sew the Rows
Together to Finish
the Pinwheel Block
(Block should
measure $12\frac{1}{2}$
inches)

Please make 2 blocks by following instructions for August meeting 1 for drawing 1 for Eagle Ranch quilt. We had 23 participating in block drawing in July. Thanks to you all. These 2 block patterns will be combined to make one quilt.

Cut 2 light and 2 dark 7 inch squares. Draw line corner to corner, stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ in from line, cut on the line. You now have 2 half square triangle units. Repeat to make 2 more. Press to dark side and join as shown in diagram. This makes $12\frac{1}{2}$ in unfinished block.

Thank you, Long arm quilters for your help. I gave out 6 and I will have 6 more next month.

Join us on Project Day July 18th for sewing, fun and fellowship.
