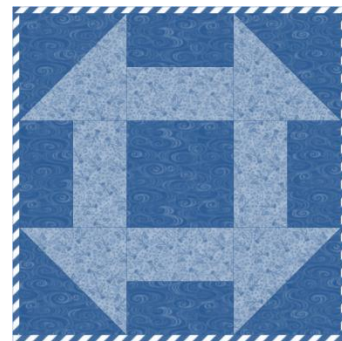

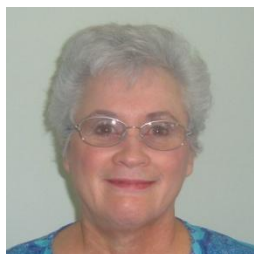
## PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE:

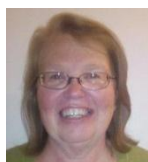
## General Meeting Minutes

August 1, 2011

We saw her slides and she showed us her quilts. There will be a class this afternoon. After a 15 minute break we had reports.

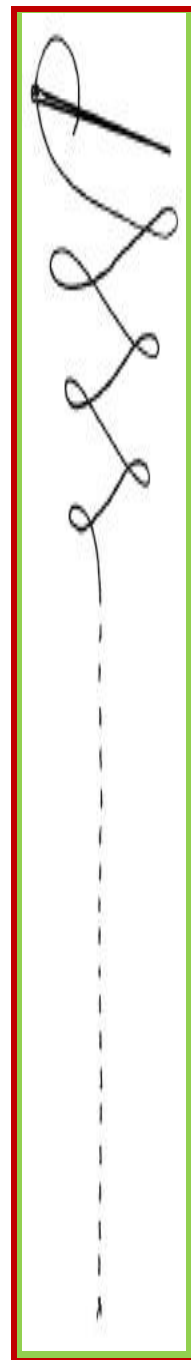

**September 12th**

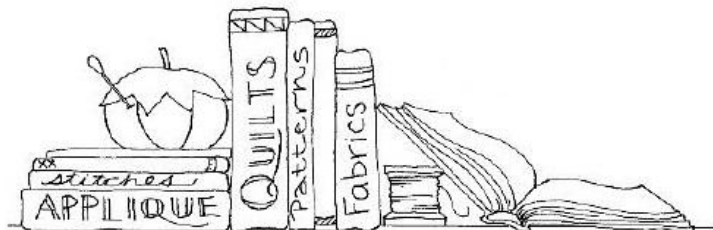

## HALL COUNTY QUILT GUILD FALL CHALLENGE

If you would like to do this challenge, see Joan Garland at the next guild meeting for the fabric and a copy of the rules.

Use at least ½ of the Fat Quarter (FQ) you received. It must be used on the front of the quilt, not the backing. Other colors used must be some of the colors that are in the FQ you received.

1. Size: no smaller than 20" x 20", no larger than 30" x 30"
2. Any quilt medium is acceptable, pieced, paper pieced or appliqué, use of embellishments is also acceptable.
3. Any design is acceptable.
4. All entries must contain 3 layers and must be quilted by hand or machine and have a binding.
5. Must be a member of Hall County Quilt Guild.

Due date: November 7, 2011 at the regular guild meeting.

Winners will be determined by viewer's choice. First, second and third place.

All entries will be hung and shown at the next Chicken quilt show/Gainesville Chicken Festival.





Ladies first I want to thank you all for the squares for Eagle Ranch quilts. I received about 60 of the 9 patch but only 30 of the pinwheel. **Georgia Quilt Show** returns to Gwinnett Center in Duluth, October 20-22, 2011 with exciting additions to the classrooms and exhibit hall. An extensive display of competition and faculty quilts will add color and inspiration to the Exhibit Hall. In addition, The Alliance for American Quilts will hang a display of 118 small auction quilts and 12 exceptional pieces representing Quilters Save Our Stories (Q.S.O.S.). Over 300 quilts will be at the center of **Georgia Quilt Show**! Quilts entered into competition will be juried in early September and judging will occur at Georgia Quilt Show 2011 where NQA certified judges will award a \$1,000 Prize for Best of Show. First, Second and Third place awards in each of three categories: Bed Quilt, Large Wall Quilt and Small Wall Quilt, will share \$4,500 in cash prizes. Ribbons for Honorable Mention and Judges' Choice will round out the recognitions.
