

The fabric needs to be 100% good quality cotton fabric. We will mix up the squares in a large bin and then pull out of the mix 200 pieces for you to randomly sew together and get an interesting 9 patch display. If you are wondering why do this? Well you could make and give the quilt to Eagle Ranch or make a quilt for a friend.

August 1st Eileen Sullivan will be doing the program on Foundation piecing. We will be doing a Iris which will be a Monday afternoon workshop so if you have questions about it now is the time to take a excellent workshop to learn how to foundation piece.


Treasurer Report 3/31-4/31/2011

GENERAL PROGRAM INFORMATION

It is time again to make plans for your quilting getaway. Meet us in the beautiful Georgia Mountains for the ***Quilting in Toccoa – Fall 2011***. The days will be filled with quilting, fabulous vendor shopping, and time to visit with old and new quilting friends.

Treat yourself – you deserve it!

LOCATION: The retreat will be held at the Georgia Baptist Conference Center on beautiful Lake Louise, just a few miles outside of Toccoa, Georgia.

COST: from \$295.00. The fee includes three nights lodging at the Conference Center and all meals (Monday evening through Thursday morning). See the *REGISTRATION FORM* for more details.

REGISTRATION: will remain open on a space available basis. A non-refundable registration fee of \$50.00 must be received with your completed form. Only one form per envelope please.

ARRIVAL: Registration will begin Monday afternoon at **3 p.m.** PLEASE DO NOT ARRIVE EARLY. Dinner will be served at 5:00 p.m. The registration desk will be open until 7 p.m.

CLASSES: Five talented teachers will be offering a wide variety of classes. Each class covers the length of the retreat. You will not have to move your work space! Be sure to indicate your first and second choice. Classes will be assigned after June 1, 2010. Every effort will be made to place you in your desired class. Due to limited space in the classrooms, assignments will be made by lottery if necessary.

“SEW-ON-YOUR-OWN”: You can work on your own project at your own speed. *No teacher will be available*, just the company of other quilters.

SPECIAL EVENTS: A general information session will follow dinner Monday evening at 6:30 p.m. **We will also have a celebration of the 20th year of the retreat on Monday evening. If you have photos or projects from earlier retreats – please bring to display.** Heirlooms and Comforts will be on campus with lots of fabrics, books and notions for your shopping pleasure. A “Stitch ‘N Sell” market as well as other quilting fun will be available in the evenings. There will be time to fellowship with your quilting friends and enjoy the beautiful surroundings at Lake Louise. And don’t worry – we are saving plenty of time for quilting and don’t forget to sign up for a massage.

FOOD SERVICE: All meals will be provided by the Conference Center and are included in the registration fee. A snack room will be available for nibbling and the ice cream shop will be open for an evening treat.

REFUND POLICY: Refunds will be subject to a \$50.00 processing fee until **October 1, 2011**. **No refunds will be made after this date, although substitute registrations can be made by notifying the retreat director.**
