
## PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

We wonder what we are going to do. Someone Else left a wonderful example to follow, but who is going to follow it? Who is going to do the things Someone Else did?


When you are asked to help this year, remember- we can't depend on Someone Else anymore.

## HALL COUNTY QUILT GUILD FALL CHALLENGE

If you plan on doing the Fall Challenge, you were given a fat quarter at the guild meeting in the last 2 months.

*Here are the challenge rules.*

Use at least 1/2 of the Fat Quarter (FQ) you received. It must be used on the front of the quilt, not the backing. Other colors used must be some of the colors that are in the FQ you received.

1. Size. no smaller than 20" x 20", no larger than 30" x 30"
2. Any quilt medium is acceptable, pieced, paper pieced, or appliquéd, use of embellishments are also acceptable.
3. Any design is acceptable.
4. All entries must contain 3 layers and must be quilted by hand or machine and have a binding.
5. Must be a member of Hall County Quilt Guild

**Due Date: November 7, 2011** at the regular guild meeting.

Winners will be determined by Viewer's choice. First, second and third place.

All entries will be hung and shown at the next Chicken Quilt show during the Gainesville Chicken Festival.

Thanks to Deb Henderson, for giving an excellent lecture on how to kick up our quilts. We had a wonderful workshop with helpful hints to make our quilting easier. Thanks to all who stayed.

This October meeting we will have a great opportunity to have Susan Brubaker Knab who will help us with needle turn appliquéd for the terrified. I am looking forward to having a full day of learning on *October 4<sup>th</sup>*. If you would like to sign up you may call or email me and I will get you the supply list. Even if you are good at needle turn appliquéd, do try to come because Susan is a great teacher on any subject.

**DEADLINE:** For turning Quilts in to qualify for charms is November 21st. at Project Day. Otherwise they will be counted the next year.



*Tips about making quilt tops:*

Remove selvage from fabric before cutting your pattern (exception on backing see below)

If your pattern has several seams coming together PLEASE press seams open. Our Long arm machines only have a limited clearance. When we hit these areas we have to go around them.

*Making the Back:*

Measure the width of the top plus 8 inches along the selvage edge of fabric. Usually 2 times of the width will give you the length needed if your fabric is 42 inches wide. Put two fabrics right sides together. Take selvage off edges and sew  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch seam for strength in quilting process. If you need to piece the back do that in the center so you don't have a seam close to the edge of the quilt. Attention to directional design on fabric.



**Georgia Quilt Show** returns to Gwinnett Center in Duluth, October 20-22, 2011 with exciting additions to the classrooms and exhibit hall. An extensive display of competition and faculty quilts will add color and inspiration to the Exhibit Hall. In addition, The Alliance for American Quilts will hang a display of 118 small auction quilts and 12 exceptional pieces representing Quilters Save Our Stories (Q.S.O.S.). Over 300 quilts will be at the center of **Georgia Quilt Show!** Quilts entered into competition will be juried in early September and judging will occur at Georgia Quilt Show 2011 where NQA certified judges will award a \$1,000 Prize for Best of Show.
