On May 2nd we will hear from Tara Miller. She is a quilt designer, maker, and enthusiast. She serves on the Board of Directors of the American Quilt Study Group (AQSG), a member of the Modern Quilt Guild, and founded the Atlanta Quilt Study Group in 2019..



She will present Graphic Quilts of the 20th Century. This presentation is packed with graphic, visually stunning quilts from the whole of the 20th century. Many of these have a surprisingly modern aesthetic! Throughout the conversation, we'll put these quilts in context: historically, socially, artistically. We'll explore some of our connections with the past that inform us, inspire us, and drive us in the art and practice of quilt making today.



### Legacy Wheel

Legacy Wheel is a fast and dynamic finish with 24" blocks! Gentle curves are easy to sew and create gorgeous lines and movement in your quilt — with very little effort. More bang for your buck, as they say!

This quilt looks amazing in modern, traditional, and reproduction fabrics. Included with the pattern are paper templates for you to print and trace, but you will save a TON of time tracing and cutting if you get the 24" block Wheels acrylic templates! You'll be done cutting and ready to sew super fast with those.






# Medallion Mystery Quilt Along
