## Baby, it's COLD outside!! **Feathered Star Class**

Our class will focus on the feathered star which is the center of the pattern Baby It's Cold Outside.

The feathered star block itself finishes 18-1/2" square. The whole quilt is 48" square and the complete pattern will be provided as part of the class.

A pre-class cutting chart will be provided to those signing up for the class. We can make better headway if everyone cuts and makes the feathers prior to class sewing time. I'd rather guide you with the sewing than watch you cut. Complete and easy to follow cutting instructions will be provided to participants well in advance.
